

STATUTES OF THE ASSOCIATION

Aurum Heaven Community Switzerland e.V.

Zurich, January 15, 2026

1. Name and Registered Office

1.1 Under the name "Aurum Heaven Community Switzerland e.V.," an association exists within the meaning of Articles 60 et seq. of the Swiss Civil Code (ZGB), with its registered office at Schiffslaende 26, CH-8001 Zurich.

1.2 The Association is politically and denominationally neutral.

2. Purpose

2.1 The Association pursues ideological, social, and non-profit objectives.

2.2 Promotion of financial education, precious metal awareness, and sustainable wealth accumulation.

2.3 Support of members through the provision of an Unconditional Basic Income (UBI).

2.4 Promotion of community-based living and economic models based on trust, ethics, and sustainability.

2.5 Organization of educational programs, seminars, and events.

2.6 The Association does not pursue profit-oriented goals. Surpluses serve the Association's purpose exclusively.

3. Resources

3.1 To achieve its purposes, the Association has the following resources at its disposal: membership fees, donations, gifts, bequests, income from projects, and gold investments.

3.2 All resources shall be used exclusively for the purposes of the Association.

3.3 The accounting system clearly distinguishes between general resources and earmarked UBI funds.

3.4 The Association may, by resolution of the Board, take out loans from private or legal persons/entities.

4. Social Fund and Basic Income (UBI)

4.1 The Association maintains an Aurum Heaven Social and Basic Income Fund (UBI Fund).

4.2 This fund serves to support members and third parties in promoting stability and quality of life.

4.3 The UBI is provided without consideration and does not establish an employment relationship.

4.4 The Board shall decide on the amount, duration, and circle of recipients.

5. Membership

5.1 Any natural or legal person who supports the goals of the Association may become a member.

5.2 Resignation may be declared in writing at any time. Contributions are not refundable.

5.3 The Board may exclude members if they violate the interests or the reputation of the Association.

6. Governing Bodies of the Association

6.1 The governing bodies of the Association are: a) The General Meeting (GM), b) The Board, c) The Auditors.

7. General Meeting (GM)

7.1 The Ordinary GM takes place once a year. Extraordinary meetings may be convened.

7.2 Duties: Approval of the minutes, election of the Board, determination of fees, amendment of the Statutes, dissolution of the Association.

7.3 Resolutions are passed by a simple majority. In the event of a tie, the President shall have the casting vote.

8. The Board

8.1 The Board consists of at least three members and constitutes itself.

8.2 It represents the Association externally and is responsible for the implementation of the Association's purpose.

8.3 It may employ or commission persons and pay them reasonable compensation.

8.4 The Board, or a member appointed for this purpose, may—with a power of attorney issued by the Association—open and maintain bank accounts in the name of the Association and negotiate and sign contracts on its behalf.

9. Aurum Heaven Social and UBI Fund

9.1 The Association maintains an Aurum Heaven Social and UBI Fund to support members and third parties.

9.2 The resources come from donations, contributions, and income. The Board decides on

their utilization.

10. Bequest and Disposition

10.1 Members may declare that their association assets shall fall to the Association in the event of death.

10.2 This disposition is voluntary, in writing, and revocable at any time.

11. Compensation and Employment

11.1 Board members may receive reasonable compensation.

11.2 The Association may employ or commission staff.

12. Auditors

12.1 The GM may elect an auditing body to audit the annual accounts and submit a report.

13. Liability

13.1 Only the Association's assets are liable for its obligations. Personal liability of the members is excluded.

14. Financial Year

14.1 The financial year corresponds to the calendar year. Closing as of December 31 in each case.

15. Dissolution

15.1 Dissolution can only be decided by the GM.

15.2 The Association's assets shall be transferred to a non-profit organization with a similar purpose.

15.3 Distribution among members is excluded.

16. Entry into Force

16.1 These Statutes were approved at the founding meeting on January 15, 2026, in Zurich and enter into force immediately.
